#### PROFILE

Stacey is an experienced registered Paediatric Nurse with extensive clinical and case management experience within the NHS and independent sector, both in the UK. She qualified as a nurse in 2004 and began her career in Neonatal intensive care. She then progressed her career via a secondment opportunity and completed the Specialist Community Public Health Nurse degree, focusing on Child and Adolescent public health surveillance, within state and independently funded schools.

It was shortly after that Stacey joined Greater Manchester Police within the Safeguarding Vulnerable Persons unit where she worked as a Case Management Lead for over a decade. To maintain her nursing registration whilst working for the police, Stacey worked at Mastercall, the out of hours emergency service. Here she also assessed and triaged adult patients for over five years.

In addition, during this time Stacey studied Law which she privately funded and successfully secured both her Law Degree and Masters in Law. After working as a paralegal for Slater & Gordon and Irwin Mitchell solicitors, Stacey began working as a Case Manager in 2021 and combined her medical knowledge with her law, concentrating initially on paediatric clients that had suffered from catastrophic injuries, birth injuries and adolescents with acquired brain injuries. Whilst working as a case manager Stacey's caseload increased and she was able to consolidate her previous experience of working with and caring for adult clients.
