PROFILE

NURSING EXPERIENCE AND CLINICAL CURRENCY

Began her career on the Gastroenterology Ward at Cheltenham General Hospital before moving into primary care as a Nursing Sister. She currently works as a GP practice nurse providing care for patients with complex and life-limiting conditions including amputations, severe wounds, burns, ileostomies, colostomies. Her current clinical work includes wound management, colostomy and ileostomy support, post amputation care, baby immunisations, vaccinations, care of PICC lines and PEG sites. Jane is highly experienced in the assessment of patient needs and liaising with patients and families regarding care at home. This provides her with ongoing practical insight into community-based care, functional dependency, equipment needs and the support required by patients and families.

Jane also has eight years' experience as a foster carer for Barnardo's. During this time, she provided care for a highly dependent disabled child with a catastrophic non-accidental brain injury. Her role required anticipation of care needs, delivery of round-the-clock support and close liaison with multidisciplinary teams to optimise wellbeing and quality of life. This experience gives her a detailed practical understanding of complex care packages, access to services and the day-to-day demands placed on families and carers.

Jane regularly works with clients in the terminal stages of respiratory disease. In her role as a Practice Nurse, she assesses patients and makes referrals to respiratory teams as their illness progresses. She remains up to date with clinical developments aimed at prolonging life expectancy, including the delivery of immunotherapies. She also undertakes hospice nursing shifts, caring for individuals with catastrophic and life-limiting conditions. This gives her an in-depth understanding of changing care needs during the terminal and end-of-life period, with particular focus on respiratory complications.
